Notice is hereby given that G. H. Taylor of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a certain lot of fir cordwood, and a certain dock known as the Nelson Creek Dock, being about 450 cords in quantity, which was cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, are marked thus no mark, and 150 cords of said wood are now lying in the S.E. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 24, Tp. 3, N.R. 7 E. 7. N. - 150 cords of said cordwood are now lying Lot 5 and 8 in Sec. 26, Tp. 3, N.R. 7 1/2 E. 7. N. - 150 cords of said cordwood are now lying in or near the wharf on the Columbia River in Lot 13 in Sec. 26, Tp. 3, N.R. 7 1/2 E. 7. N. all of the above being in Skamania Co. Wash. for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in securing and obtaining and fluming said cordwood, and labor performed in constructing said dock; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is J. D. Crawford; that J. D. Crawford employed said G. H. Taylor to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

That said J. D. Crawford agreed to pay the said G. H. Taylor for such labor and assistance; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said G. H. Taylor, who performed labor upon and assisted in obtaining and securing and fluming said cordwood, and building said dock for the period of 26 days @ \$2.50 per day, 2 months and 11 days @ \$40. per month, that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said cordwood and upon said dock between the 12th day of March, 1900, and the 23 day of June, 1900, and the rendition of said service was closed on the 23 day of June, 1900, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$159.66; that no part thereof has been paid except —, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credit and offsets, the sum of \$159.66, in which amount he claims a lien upon the said fir cordwood and said Nelson Creek dock.

The said G. H. Taylor also claims a lien on all said cordwood and said dock now owned by said J. D. Crawford of said County and State to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said fir cordwood and building said dock herein described.
