This indenture, made this (8th) Eighth day of October, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty Nine (1869) between George Miller, and James H. P. Wiley, of Skamania County, Washington Territory, parties of the first part, and Moses Bollman of the same County and Territory, party of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars, to them in hand paid by the party of the second part, - at or before the executing and delivery these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have remised, released, and quit-claimed, and by these presents, do remise, release, and quit-claim, unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs, and assigns forever, All that certain parcel, or tract of land, situated in the County of Skamania, in the Territory of Washington, and bounded, and described as follows. Beginning at a rock, on the north bank of the Columbia River, at the South East corner of William M. Murphy's Donation Land Claim, described in his Notification No 837. Thence North Sixty Chains, to a Stake, Thence West: Seventy Seven (27) Chains, to Wind River, Thence South to the Columbia River, Thence up stream by the meanders, of the Columbia River to the place of beginning, Containing One Hundred and Sixty Acres, more, or less, with all and singular, the tenements, hereof, and appurtenances, thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and the reversions and reversions, remainder, and remainders, rents, issues, and profits, thereof.
