

Location of the Rossie Claim by J R & E C Cole

Notice of Location

To whom it may concern

Notice is hereby given, That we J. R. Cole and E. C. Cole a citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington, and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the 12th day of Sept. A.D. 1896, locate and by this notice do hereby locate a Luster Claim, known as the Rossie Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered the 12th day of September 1896, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins (or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) (twenty acres of mining ground) situated in Copper Creek Dist. County of Shumacher State of Wash. said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit;

This claim lies above the Big Elephant just above the left hand branch of Copper Creek about 500 feet above the junction running 1500 feet from the center of the Creek by 20 degrees W of S and 200 feet each way from center notice which is put on one Hemlock tree and about 10 feet from one small falls in the Creek.

And we intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
