In compliance with the U.S. mining laws and the regulations of St. Helens Mining District, Kamiah County, Idaho & Washington, I located the South West Discovering Claim of the Elkhorn Lode, Locality: on Fall Creek, a Southern tributary of the Lost Tule River, about $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile south of the trail from the Forks to Camp Samson about three miles east from Manning Creek on the West slope of 1st Gold Range, Boundary: From the discovery in the creek bed above the great Falls of the Creek 300 feet South 8° East then 1500 feet South 82° West, then 600 feet North 8° West, then 1500 feet North 82° East then 300 feet South 8° East to place of beginning.

Location of Galeonda Lode S.W. Discovering Claim By C. E. Patzer

Notice of Location

In compliance with the U.S. mining laws and the regulations of St. Helens Mining District, I located the South West Discovering Claim of the Galeonda Lode, Kamiah County, Idaho & Washington. Locality: On Galeonda creek $\frac{1}{4}$ mile north-east from the river camp in Samson basin upper North Tule valley, one second Creek from Samson Camp in Southeastern direction. Boundary: From place of discovery in Creek bed 300 ft North 5° West; thence 1500 ft South 85° West, then 600 ft South 5° East, then 1500 ft North 85° East, then 600 ft North 5° West to place of beginning.
