BLAISDELL HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED AND DULY CONSUMATED, IN CONFORMITY TO LAW, FOR THE

WEST HALF OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER AND THE WEST HALF OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION TWENTY-SIX IN TOWNSHIP FOUR NORTH OF RANGE SEVEN EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, WASHINGTON, CONTAINING TWENTY-FIVE ACRES, ACCORDING TO THE OFFICIAL PLAT OF THE SURVEY OF THE SAID LAND, RETURNED TO THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE BY THE SURVEYOR-GENERAL:

NOW KNOW YE, THAT THEREIS, THEREFORE, GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES UNTO
THE SAID CLAIMANT THE TRACT OF LAND ABOVE DESCRIBED; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAID
TRACT OF LAND, WITH THE APPURTENANCES THEREOF, UNTO THE SAID CLAIMANT AND TO THE
HEIRS AND ASSIGNS OF THE SAID CLAIMANT FOREVER; SUBJECT TO ANY VESTED AND ACCRUED
WATER RIGHTS FOR MINING, AGRICULTURAL, MANUFACTURING, OR OTHER PURPOSES AND RIGHTS
TO DITCHES AND RESERVOIRS USED IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH WATER RIGHTS, AS MAY BE
RECOGNIZED AND ACKNOWLEDGED BY THE LOCAL CUSTOMS, LAWS, AND DECISIONS OF COURTS;
AND THERE IS RESERVED FROM THE LANDS HEREBY GRANTED A RIGHT OF WAY THEREON FOR DITCHES
OR CANALS CONSTRUCTED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE UNITED STATES.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, WARREN G. HARDING, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, HAVE CAUSED THESE DETTERSHOOD BE MADE PATENT, AND THE SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE TO BE HEREUNTO AFFIXED.
