

Notice of Location of Tunnel Rights.

Notice is hereby given to all whom this may concern: That the undersigned has this day located (under the laws of the United States and laws of the State of Washington) and claims the right to construct and operate a tunnel commencing at or near this point: where this notice is posted, about three hundred feet westerly from the "Grey Eagle" claim on the south bank of Blue Bird Creek, in Skamania County, Washington, and running there in a westerly direction three thousand feet (3000 feet), with the right to hold and work all leads, lodes and veins for 1500 feet in length, discovered by reason of the construction of said proposed tunnel.
