

Notice of Location.

To Whom it May Concern:

Notice is hereby given, That I, Charles W. Bagham, a citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Twenty-two of the Revised Statute of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the 1st day of October A.D., 1896, locate, and by this do hereby locate a Quartz Claim, known as the "Jennie M" Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered the 1st day of October 1896, and does claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the entire thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries,) (twenty acres of mining ground), situated in Copper Creek District, County of Skamania, State of Washington, said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly in respect as follows, to-wit:

This claim is known as the extension of the claim known as "Lillie M", running 500 feet 10 degrees E. of S., and 300 feet each way from center. The notice is on an Hecloeth tree at the end of said claim known as "Lillie M."

And I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the mining laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
