

Lein of P. E. Michell vs Stormen Lumbering Co.

Notice is hereby given that P. E. Michell of Skamania County Washington, claims a lien upon a certain steam saw-mill with all the boilers engine and fixtures of whatever description in said saw-mill, situated on the Henry Shepard donation land claim in Twp 27 S R 7 E 1/2 East Willamette Meridian in Skamania County Washington, for labor performed and assistance rendered in setting up and placing boiler and engine in said saw-mill, also helping keeping books, as book-keeper for said Stormen Lumbering Company that the owner of the same or reputed owner is Stormen Lumbering Company; that E. Hayes is president and manager of said Stormen Lumbering Company; that said E. Hayes is president as president and manager employed said P. E. Michell to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: That said E. Hayes agreed to pay the said P. E. Michell for such labor and assistance Fifty (\$50.00) per month; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said P. E. Michell who performed labor upon and assisted in setting up and placing said boiler and engine in said mill, also keeping books as book-keeper for the period of 3 and 2/3 months; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said boiler and engine and as book-keeper between the 4th day of April 1898, and the 2nd day of August, 1898, and 30 days have not elapsed since that time, and the rendition of said service was ceased on the 2nd day of August, 1898, and

30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said service is \$197 ¹⁶/₁₀₀; that no part thereof has been paid except \$59 ⁷⁰/₁₀₀, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets the sum of \$137 ⁷⁰/₁₀₀ in which amount he claims a lien upon said saw-mill and all fixtures and engines in said saw-mill. That said O. E. Michell also claims a lien upon all the household property used in operating said saw-mill business now owned by said Stevenson Lumbering Company, and E. Hayes of said County and State to secure the payment for the work and labor performed as herein described.
