Notice of Location

In compliance with the U.S. Mining Laws and the regulations of St. Helens Mining District, Klamath County State of Washington. I located the North West Discovery claim of the Ulsatia Lode

Locality: German Gulch, about 1/4 mile West of the Samson basin of the upper North Fork river valley, on South slope of Mt. Mountain, about 1/2 mile North of the trail from the forks to camp Samson, about 800 ft. higher than Tautle river. Discovery in Creek bed and slopes of gulch.

Boundaries: From place of Discovery 500 ft. North 10° East then 1500 ft North 80° West thence 600 ft South 10° West; then 1500 ft South 80° East; then 300 ft North 10° East to place of beginning. Direction Magnetic. feet linear.
