Notice is hereby given that T. S. Richards of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon the franchise, earnings and all the real and personal property of J. D. Crawford, which is used in the operation of his said timber business, in Skamania County, Washington, to the extent of the moneys due him, from said J. D. Crawford, operating said franchise or business, for labor performed in and about said J. D. Crawford's timber business as hereinafter set forth.

That the said property of the said J. D. Crawford upon which the claimant herein claims a lien is situated as follows, to-wit:

1027 ft. Railroad ties situated on the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25, Tp. 3, N. R. 7, E. T. M. in Skamania County, Washington, also flume known as Nixon Creek flume running through and situate upon S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ and N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25, Tp. 3, N. R. 7, E. T. M. in Skamania Co. Wash. also one wharf situate on Lot 13, Sec. 26, Tp. 3 N. R. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. T. M. on bank of Columbia River; also one span of horses and set of harness and any and tools and machinery used in the operation of said business, all of said property being situated in Skamania County, Washington.

This lien is claimed for work and labor performed and assistance rendered by the claimant for the said J. D. Crawford in sawing wood, in constructing flume, swinging rock, in the operation of said timber business in Skamania County Washington.

That the name of the owner or reputed owner is J. D. Crawford, that said J. D. Crawford employed said T. S. Richards to perform such labor and under such assistance on the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

That the said J. D. Crawford agreed to pay said T. S. Richards for such labor and assistance, the sum of \$35.00 for all work and labor performed.

That said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said T. S. Richards, who performed labor in and about said timber business for the period of 19 days.

That said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered between the 1st day of March, 1900, and the 14th day of April, 1900, and the rendition of said services were closed on the 14th day of April, 1900, and ninety days have not elapsed since that time. That the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$35.00; that no part thereof has been paid, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$35.

in which amount the claimant herein claims a lien upon the property of the said J. D. Crawford, heretofore fully described.
