Notice is hereby given that Joseph Handrub of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon the franchise, earnings and all the real and personal property of J. D. Crawford, which is used in the operations of his said timber business, in Skamania County, Washington, to the extent of the moneys due him, from said J. D. Crawford, operating said franchise or business, for labor performed on and about said J. D. Crawford's timber business as hereinafter set forth.

That the said property of the said J. D. Crawford upon which the claimant herein claims a lien is situated as follows, to-wit:

1027 fir Railroad ties situate on the South East Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section 24, Township Three North Range Seven East of the T.M. and the North East Quarter of Section 25, Township 3 North Range Seven East of the T.M. also flume known as Nelson Creek flume running through and situate upon the North East 1/4 of Sec. 25, Town 3 North Range Seven East of the T.M. Mer. also on the South East 1/4 of the South East 1/4 of Section 24, Township Three North Range 7 East of T.M. Mer. also one wharf situate on Lot 13 in Section 26 Town 3 North Range 7 1/2 East of the T.M. on the bank of the Columbia River, also one span of horses one set of harness and any and all tools and machinery used in the operation of said business, all of the above property being situate in Skamania County, State of Washington.

This lien is claimed for work and labor performed and assistance rendered by the claimant for the said J. D. Crawford as laborer in cutting & shewing said Railroad ties, in the operation of said timber business in Skamania County, Washington.

That the name of the owner or reputed owner is J. D. Crawford; that said J. D. Crawford employed said Joseph Handrub, to perform such labor and render such assistance on the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

That the said J. D. Crawford agreed to pay said Joseph Handrub for such labor and assistance, the sum of 18 cents per tie for all work and labor performed.

That said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Joseph Handrub, who performed labor in and about said timber business for the period of 75 days.

That said Joseph Handrub cut and shewed for said J. D. Crawford 1027 Railroad ties pursuant to said contract.

That said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered between the 1st day of March, 1900, and the 15th day of May, 1900, and:

The rendition of said services were closed on the 18th day of May, 1900, and ninety days have not elapsed since that time. That the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$184 ⁸⁶/₁₀₀; that no part thereof has been paid except \$100.00, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$84. ⁸⁶/₁₀₀, in which amount the claimant herein claims a lien upon the property of the said J. D. Crawford, hereinbefore fully described.
