

Notice of Location of Starlight Lode by Leonard L. Higgins

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter VII, Title 52, of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the local laws, customs and regulations of this district has located 1000 fifteen hundred linear feet in length by two six hundred feet in width, on the Starlight lode, or deposit bearing precious metal situated in the Green Bald and Silver Star Mountain Mining district, Garman County, State of Washington, this location being described and marked on the ground as follows, to-wit:

(Refers to stakes, monuments, etc., of exterior lines of discovery)
700 feet each way from this opening in a westerly and easterly direction and 300 feet each way from center of lode in width taking in all dips and angles of said lode.

The mining claim above described shall be known as the Starlight.
