

Jo. T. Peters vs Thomas Connell.

Notice is hereby given that Joseph T. Peters, of Wasco County, Oregon, claims a lien upon a certain lot of railroad ties, being about thirty-one hundred and fifty-five ties in quantity which were cut and manufactured in Skamania County, Washington on the land owned by the Dalles, Portland and Astoria Navigation Company, a corporation, which said land adjoins the Columbia River in front of the town of Stevenson, in said county and state, and said ties being now situated on said land and near the Steamboat Landing used by the steamer's belonging to said Dalles, Portland and Navigation Company, and being the only ties situated on said land or any part thereof near the said Steamboat Landing, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in obtaining and securing said ties and partly also in hauling and transporting said ties from a point about 2 miles north of said Steamboat Landing to where said ties are now situated as aforesaid; that the name of the owner or reputed owner, of said ties is Thomas Connell; that the said Thomas Connell employed the said Peters to perform such labor and render such assistance as aforesaid in hauling and transporting said ties upon the following terms and conditions to-wit:-

The said Connell agreed to pay the said Peters the sum of four cents for each and every tie so hauled and transported as aforesaid and for such labor and assistance; that the said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of the said Peters, who performed labor upon and assisted, and under his direction had labor performed upon said ties in so hauling transporting and in obtaining and securing said ties as aforesaid for the period of 48 days, that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said ties between the 1st day of June, 1900, and the 18th day of July, 1900, and the rendition of said service was closed on the 18th day of July, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is one hundred and twenty-six and 20/100 dollars (\$126.20); that no part thereof has been paid, and that there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the said sum of \$126.20, in which amount he claims a lien upon said ties. The said

Peters also claims a lien on all said ties now owned by the said Thomas Connell to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said rail road ties herein described.
