

Location of "J. K." Claim, by James F. McFeighan

Notice of Location

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of Chapter VI, Title 32 of the Revised Statutes of the United States, and the local laws, customs and regulations of this district has located fifteen hundred acres of land in length by six hundred feet in width, on this the J. K. Lode, vein or deposit bearing precious metals (or twenty acres placer claim) situated in Silver Mountain Mining District, Skamania County, State of Washington, this location being described and marked on the ground as follows, to-wit: Refer to stakes, monument, etc., of exterior lines of discovery) commencing at Location Stake and running Northerly (900) Nine Hundred and fifty feet to stake marked North end center stake. Thence westerly (300) three hundred feet to stake marked North West Corner Stake. Thence Southerly (1500) fifteen hundred feet to stake marked South West Corner Stake. Thence Easterly (300) three hundred feet to stake marked South End Center Stake. Thence Easterly (300) Three Hundred feet to stake marked South East Corner Stake. Thence Northerly (1500) fifteen hundred feet to stake marked North East Corner Stake. Thence Easterly (300) Three hundred feet to said North End Center Stake the place of beginning of outside boundary.
