Marble, his wife, in consideration of Four Hundred Dollars, to us in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, conveyed, and by these presents, do bargain, sell, and convey unto Charles Brown, of Vancouver Washington Territory, the following described premises, to wit,

The East Half, of the South West Quarter, of Section Eighteen (18) in Township (1) One, North of Range Five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing Eighty acres and Situate in the County of Vancouver Washington Territory.

Together with the hereditaments, and appurtenances, thereto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, So have and do hold the same, with the appurtenances, thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, unto the said Charles Brown his heirs, and assigns forever.

This Conveyance, is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars, and the interest thereon in accordance with the terms of a certain promissory note, of which the following is a copy:
