Witnesseth, that we, Frank Marble, and Clara

have bargained, sold, conveyed, and
by these presents, do bargain, sell, and convey
unto Charles Brown, of Vancouver Washington
Territory, the following described premises,
to wit,

The East Half, of the South West
Quarter, of Section Eighteen (18) in Township (1)
One, North of Range Five (5) East of the Will
amette Meridian, containing Eighty Acres
and situate in the County of Skamania
Washington Territory.

Together with the heredita-
timents, and appurtenances, thereto belong-
ing, or in anywise appertaining, to have
and to hold the same, with the appurtenan-
ces, thereto belonging, or in anywise ap-
pertaining, unto the said Charles Brown
his heirs, and assigns forever.

This Conveyance, is intended as a Mortgage
to secure the payment of the sum of Four
