

# Location of "Payton" Lode or Mine by Annie M Engman

Nature of Location

To Whom it may Concern:

Notice a. Leray gives That Annie M Engman, a citizen of the United States, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six by Title Twenty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the Stat. of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the 13th day of October A.D. 1896, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a Quartz Claim, known as the "Payton" Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered the 10th day of October 1896, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lead, to be or were bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) situated in Mt. Lookout Mining District, County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows to wit:
