Location of "Copper Lion" Mine by Alice M Wallace Notice of Location

To Whom it may Concern: Notice is hereby given that Alice M Wallace a Citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statute of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners did on the 12th day of October A.D. 1896, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a Quartz Claim, known as the "Copper Lion" Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered the 10th day of October 1896 and do claim (fifteen hundred acres) sit on this lead, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, apices and angles and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries, situated in Mt Tokeant Mining District County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows:

From the Post of Notice running in a North easterly direction (1000) fifteen hundred feet, and (50) seventy five feet extra to make linear feet to end Center Post, Thence from Center Post of Notice running in a South Easterly direction (300) three hundred feet and (40) forty feet extra to make linear feet to South East Corner Post, Thence in a North easterly direction (1000) fifteen hundred feet, and (80) eighty feet extra to make linear feet to North East Corner Post, Thence in a North easterly
