Notice is hereby given that Charles Cranch of Skamania County, Washington, claims a lien upon a certain Steam Saw-mill with all the fixtures, engines and fixtures of whatever description in said saw-mill situated on the Henry Shepard Donation Land Claim in Tps 28 3 N. R. 74 7 1/2 East Willamette Meridian Skamania County Washington for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in setting up and placing boiler and engine in said saw-mill; also building furnace under said boiler; also running trimmer or cut off saw in said saw-mill. That the name of the owner or reputed owner is Stormers Lumbering Company; that E. Hayes is president and manager of said Stormers Lumbering Company; That said E. Hayes as President ^{and} manager employed said Charles Cranch to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following ^{terms &} conditions, to-wit:

The said E. Hayes agreed to pay the said Charles Cranch for such labor and assistance Fifteen cents per hour that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Charles Cranch who performed labor upon and assisted in setting up and placing said boiler and engine in said saw-mill, also building furnace, under said boiler; running trimmer or cut off saw in said saw-mill for the period of 754 hours; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said boiler and engine and in said saw-mill, between the 19th day of February, 1898 and the 6th day of August 1898; and the rendition of said services was closed on the 6th day of August, 1898, and 30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of Claimants demand for said service is \$113 ⁰⁰/₁₀₀

That one part thereof has been paid, except \$84 ¹⁰/₁₀₀ and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$29 ⁴⁰/₁₀₀ in which amount he claims a lien upon said saw mill and all boilers and engines in said mill. That said Charles Cranch also claims a lien upon all the household property used in operating said saw mill now owned by said Stevenson Lumbering Co. and E. Hayes of said county and state to secure the payment for the work and labor performed as herein described

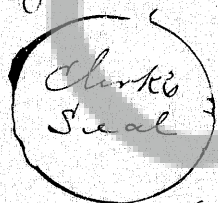
