

Location of "North Carolina" Mine by W. V. Robertson
Notice of Location

To whom it may concern Notice is hereby given that William V. Robertson a citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulation of government, on the 15th day of October AD 1896, located and by the Notice do hereby locate a Frosty Glacier, known as the "North Carolina" Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered the 11th day of October 1896, and to claim eighteen hundred linear feet on this land, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs, and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries, situated in Lookout Mountain Mining Dist. County of Skamania, State of Washington, said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

From this Post and Notice running in a North Easterly direction (500) fifteen hundred feet and (100) One hundred feet extra to make linear feet to end Center Post, thence from Center Post of Notes running in a North Easterly direction (300) three hundred feet, and (20) thirty feet extra to make linear feet to South East Corner Post, thence North Easterly (1500) fifteen hundred feet, and (90) Ninety feet extra to make linear feet to North East Corner Post, thence South Easterly (300) three hundred feet, and (40) forty feet extra to make linear feet to the end Center Post, thence South Easterly (300) three hundred feet, and (60) thirty feet extra to make linear feet to North West Corner Post, thence South Easterly (1500) fifteen hundred feet, and (100) one hundred feet extra to make linear feet to South West Corner Post, thence North Easterly (300) three hundred feet, and (50) thirty feet extra to make linear feet to Center Post of Notes and place of beginning, prospecting shaft is located in a North Easterly direction about (200) twelve hundred feet from Center Post of Notes. And I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the Mining Laws of the United States and of its State of Washington.
