

Notice of Location of Washington Lode "By Alice M. Wallace & Annie M. Engstrom."

To whom it may concern, Notice is hereby given, That Alice M. Wallace & Annie M. Engstrom, citizens of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statute of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the Twenty-fourth day of October A.D. 1896, locate, and by this Notice do hereby locate a Lode or Mining Claim, known as the "Washington Lode" Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered the Twentieth day of October, 1896, and as claim (fifty hundred acres) on this lode, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all tips, spurs and veins, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries (Twenty acres,) situated in Mt. Lookout Mining Dist., County of Skamania State of Washington said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

From this post and Notice running in a South Westerly direction (500) fifty hundred feet, and (100) one hundred feet extra to make linear feet to End Center Post; Then from Center Post of Notice again running in a North Westerly direction (200) three hundred feet and (25) twenty five feet extra to make linear feet to North West Corner Post, thence South Westerly (1000) fifty hundred feet and (100) one hundred feet extra to make linear feet to South West Corner Post, thence South Easterly (300) three hundred feet, and (30) thirty feet extra to make linear feet to End Center Post, thence South Easterly again (300) three hundred feet and (25) twenty five feet extra to make linear feet to South East Corner Post, thence North Easterly (1000) fifty hundred feet and (100) one hundred feet extra to make linear feet to North East Corner Post, thence North Westerly (300) three hundred feet and (30) thirty feet extra to make linear feet to Center Post of Notice and place of beginning. The prospecting shaft is located in a South Westerly direction about (700) seven hundred feet from Center Post of Notice and place of beginning and we intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners, and the Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
