

Notice of Location "Mother Shipton" Mine by Alex. M. Wallace
 To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given, That
 Alex. M. Wallace a citizen of the United States of America
 over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the
 requirements of Chapter, Six, of Title thirty-two of the Revised
 Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws
 then, and of the State of Washington, and the local laws
 custom, rules and regulations of miners, did, on the twenty-
 eighth day of October A.D. 1896, locate, and by this notice do hereby
 locate a quartz claim, known as the "Mother Shipton" Lode or Mining
 Claim, said claim having been discovered the second day of
 October 1896, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on this
 bed, lode or vein bearing mineral in place. & six hundred
 feet in width. the same being three hundred feet on each
 side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and
 angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which
 lies within said boundaries) (Twenty acres) situated
 in Mt Lookout Mining Dist. County of Harrison State of
 Washington, said location being described and distinctly mar-
 ked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and
 more particularly described as follows, to wit:

From the Post and Notice running in a North Easterly direction (150) fifteen hundred feet and (175) one hundred and seventy-five
 feet extra to make linear feet to end Center Post, then from Center
 Post of Notice again running in a South Easterly direction (200) three
 hundred feet, and (50) fifty feet extra to make linear feet to South
 East-Corner Post, thence North Easterly (1500)fifteen hundred feet
 and (150) one thousand and fifty feet extra to make linear feet to North
 East-Corner Post, thence North Easterly (300) three hundred feet
 and (40) forty feet extra to make linear feet to End Center Post,
 thence North Westerly again (300) three hundred feet and (50) fifty
 feet extra to make linear feet to North West Corner Post, thence
 South Westerly (1500) fifteen hundred feet and (150) one hundred
 and fifty feet extra to make linear feet to South West Corner
 Post, thence South Easterly (300) three hundred feet and (50) fifty
 feet extra to make linear feet to Center Post of Notice and place of
 beginning, the trapping shaft is located North Easterly (200) two
 hundred feet from Center Post of Notice. And I intend to
 hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs
 and rules of miners and the Miners Law of the United States and of
 the State of Washington Dated the twenty-eighth day of October 1896
