

Notice of Location of "Pond" Mine by Engman & Hunter
 To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given
 That Annie M Engman and George W Hunter, citizens of the
 United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years,
 having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six
 of Title Thirty-Two of the Revised Statutes of the United
 States and of all other mining laws thereto and
 of the State of Washington, and the local customs, laws,
 rules and regulation of business, did, on the thirtieth day
 of October A.D. 1896, locate, and by this Notice do hereby
 locate a Lode Claim, known as the "Pond" Lode or Mining
 Claim, said claim having been discovered the Twenty
 Seventh day of October 1896, and do claim fifteen hundred
 and six feet on the lead, lode or vein bearing mineral
 in place, by six hundred feet in width. the same being
 three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, to-
 gether with all dips, Spurs and angles, and all other veins
 or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries
 (Twenty acres) situated in Mt Lookout Mining Dist. County
 of Klamath, State of Washington said location being described
 and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or
 permanent monuments, and more particularly described as
 follows, to-wit:
 From the Post and Notes and
 centers of discovery shaft running in a South Easterly di-
 rection (500) fifteen hundred feet and (200) two hundred feet
 extra to make linear feet to end Center Post; thence from
 Center Post shaft again running in a North Westerly di-
 rection (300) three hundred feet and (60) sixty feet extra to
 make linear feet to North West-Corner Post; thence South Westerly
 (500) fifteen hundred feet and (175) one hundred and seventy-five
 feet extra to make linear feet to South West-Corner Post; thence
 South Easterly (300) three hundred feet and (75) Seventy-five
 feet extra to make linear feet to End Center Post; thence
 South Easterly again (300) three hundred feet and (60) Sixty
 feet extra to make linear feet to South East-Corner Post,
 thence North Easterly (1500) fifteen hundred feet and (100) one hundred
 and fifty feet extra to make linear feet to North East-Corner Post,
 itiner North Easterly (600) three hundred feet and (65) fifty-five
 feet extra to make linear feet to Center Post of Notice and place
 of origin, the above claim adjoins the South end of the "Echibator"
 and are entitled to hold and work said claim in accordance
 with the local customs and rules of Mines and the Mining Laws
