

Notice of Location of "Gladiator" lode by John M. Lieberman
 To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given that John M. Lieberman a Citizen of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof and of the State of Washington, and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the Twenty-eight day of October A.D. 1896, locate, and by this Notice do hereby locate a Lode Claim known as the "Gladiator" Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered the Second day of October, 1896, and the claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on its head lode or vein bearing mineral in place by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) (twenty acres) situated in Mt. Lookout Mining Dist. County of Skamania, State of Washington, said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit: From the Post-and-Notice running in a South Westerly direction (500) fifteen hundred feet and (100) one hundred feet extra to make linear feet to end Center Post; then from Center Post of Notice again running in a North Westerly direction (300) three hundred feet and (50) fifty feet extra to make linear feet to North West-Corner Post; thence South Westerly (1500) fifteen hundred feet and (25) twenty five feet extra to make linear feet to South West-Corner Post; thence South Easterly (300) three hundred feet and (60) sixty feet extra to make linear feet to end Center Post; thence South Easterly again (300) three hundred feet and (55) fifty five feet extra to make linear feet to South East-Corner Post; thence North Easterly (500) fifteen hundred feet, and (10) One hundred and ten feet extra to make linear feet to North East-Corner Post; thence North Westerly (300) three hundred feet and (50) fifty feet extra to make linear feet to Center Post of Notice and place of beginning. Prospecting Shaft is located South Westerly (400) four hundred feet from Center Post of Notice. And I intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of Washington dated the Twenty-eight day of October 1896.
