Notice is hereby given that GEO. SWEENEY of Skamania County, state of Washington, claims a lien upon all of the real and personal property of Rudolph Kraft, & which is used in the operation of the said Rudolph Kraft's logging business in Skamania County, state of Washington, to the extent of the money due the claimant herein for work and assistance rendered for said Rudolph Kraft upon the following terms and conditions, to wit: That GEO. Sweeney was employed by Rudolph Kraft, that the name of the owner or reputed owner of the herein after described property is Rudolph Kraft; that said Rudolph Kraft, agreed to pay the said GEO. Sweeney, for such labor and assistance \$1.45 per day; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said GEO. Sweeney, who performed labor upon and assisted in operating said logging business in building skid road and fixing donkey engine for the period of 15 days; that said labor and assistance was so performed and rendered between the 24 day of Sept., 1901, and the 12 day of Oct., 1901, and the rendition of said services was closed on the 12 day of October, 1901, and 90 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said services is \$26.25; that no part thereof has been paid except \$18.6, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$8.09, in which amount claimant claims a lien upon the following described property situated in Skamania County, state of Washington: a certain skid road commencing at or near the Nelson creek saw mill on the N.W. 1/4 of S. 1. 1/4 of sec. 25, Tp. 3, R.R. 7 1/2 E. W.M. running through lot 9, sec. 25, Tp. 3 R.R. 7 1/2 E. W.M. running thence through N.E. 1/4 of sec. 25 Tp. 3 R.R. 7 1/2 E. W.M., 1 donkey engine, Ferguson manufac., 4 x 8 cylinders; 1 cedarwood logging donkey engine 7 x 10 cylinders; 600 feet of 1/4 inch cable; 1900 feet of 1/2 inch trip line; 2 pair logging grabs, A. Ferguson make; 4 pair donkey dogs; 2 - nip stone blocks, A. Ferguson make; 1 lead block, A. Ferguson make; 1 lead block, A. Ferguson make; 1 yarding block, A. Ferguson make; 1 yonder with hook and eye, 125 feet long; 1 yonder without

hook and eye, 125 feet long, 1 yard with hook and eye, 50 feet long; 8 chopping axes with handles; 2 felling axes with handles; 4 wedges with handles; 8 wedges, felling and bucking mixed; 3 Atkins cross cut saws; 6 1/2 feet long; 1 Simmons No. 6 foot felling saw 7 feet long, and 8 inches; 2 claw hammers; 1 machine hammer; 1 monkey wrench; 1 pipe wrench; 1 Martin spike; 1 glue cleaner; 3 coal chisels; 3 steel punches; 2 block loops; 3 block straps; 800 feet signal line; 5 saw handles; 2 shovels; 3 picks; 2 grubbing toes; 1 scate rule; 6 peaveys; 1 road line, 125 feet long; 1 road line 50 feet long, 10 gals skid oil; 1 1/2 gals cylinder oil; 10 lbs Tazier's axle grease; 1 pair spadeoers; 4 single trees with clips; 1 oldudebates wagon with top bar and seat, neck joke, double trees and single trees; 9 pair coupling dogs; 4 pair single dogs with chains, 1 bar 1 1/2 inch steel, 5 feet long, round; 1 bar 1 1/4 inch iron, 7 feet long; 2 set logging harness ropeshags; 1 set wagon harness; 4 head stalls; 1 team of horses as "Dick" weighing about 1400 lbs, blind in one eye, two white hind feet, scar on right hip - "Darley" weighing about 1400 lbs, one white hind foot, brand indistinct; 1 team of horses black and bay, "Grant" light bay weighing about 1280 lbs, white stripe on forehead - "Barney" black weighing about 1250 lbs.
