Elkhorn Lodge N.E. Discovery Claim S. H. S. Kellogg
Duplicate Notice of Location

In compliance with the U.S. Mining Laws and the regulations of the St. Helens Mining District, I located the Northeast Discovery claim of the Elkhorn Lodge, Skamania County, State of Washington, Locality: On Falls Creek, a southern tributary of the North Tule River, about 1/4 of a mile south of the trail from the forks to Camp Samson, about three miles East from Minner Park on the North slope of the Cold Range. Boundaries: From the discovery in creek bed above the great falls of the creek 300 feet North 8° West, then 1000 feet North 82° East, then 600 feet South 8° East, then 1000 feet South 82° West, then 300 feet North 8° West to place of beginning, Directions Magnetic, feet hereon.
