Notice is hereby given that Wm. Sweeney, of Skamania county, state of Washington, claims a lien upon all of the real and personal property of Rudolph Kraft, which is used in the operation of the said Rudolph Kraft's logging business in Skamania county, state of Washington, to the extent of moneys due the claimant herein for work and assistance rendered for said Rudolph Kraft upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit: That Wm. Sweeney was employed by Rudolph Kraft, that the name of the owner or reputed owner of the hereinafter described property is Rudolph Kraft; that said Rudolph Kraft, agreed to pay the said Wm. Sweeney, for such labor and assistance \$1.75 per day; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Wm. Sweeney, who performed labor upon and assisted in operating said logging business in building skid road, sawing wood for donkey for the period of 17 1/2 days; that said labor and assistance was so performed and rendered between the 23 day of Sept, 1901, and the 12 day of Oct., 1901, and the rendition of said services was closed on the 12 day of Oct., 1901, and 90 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said services ~~was closed on the 12 day of Oct., 1901,~~ is \$29.61; that no part thereof has been paid except \$24.74, and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$4.87, in which amount claimant claims a lien upon the following described property situated in Skamania county, state of Washington: a certain skid road commencing at or near the Nelson Creek saw mill on the N.W. 1/4 of S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 25, Twp. 3 N.R. 7 1/2 E. 7. N. running through Lot 9 Sec 25 Twp. 3 N.R. 7 1/2 E. 7. N. running thence through N.E. 1/4 of Sec 25, Twp. 3 N.R. 7 E. 7. N.; 1 donkey engine, Tauger's manufacture, 7 x 8 cylinder; 1 Sedge-wood logging donkey engine; 600 feet of 1/4 inch cable; 1900 feet of 1/2 inch trip line; 2 pair logging grabs, A. Tauger's make; 4 pair donkey dogs; 2 trip line blocks, A. Tauger's make; 1 head block, A. Tauger's make; 1 lead block, A. Tauger's make; 1 yarding block, A. Tauger's; 1 yarder with hook and eye, 120 feet long; 1 yarder without

Traylor's axle grease; 1 pair spreaders; 4 single trees with clips; 1 Studebaker wagon with top box and seat, neck yoke, double trees and singletrees; 9 pair coupling dogs; 4 pair single dogs with chains; 1 bar 1 1/2 inch steel, 5 feet long, round; 1 bar 1 1/2 inch iron, 7 feet long; 2 set logging charneas rope tugs; 1 set wagon harness; 4 head stalls; 1 team of horses bays, "Dick" weighing about 1450 lbs, blind in one eye, two white hind feet, near on right hip -- "Loharley" weighing about 1400 lbs, one white hind foot, brand indistinct; 1 team of horses, black and bay, "Grant" light bay weighing about 1250 lbs, white stripe on forehead -- "Barney" black weighing about 1250 lbs.

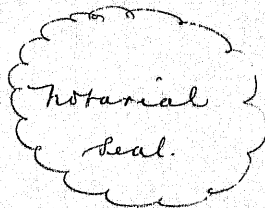
