

Notice of Location of "Genewine" by Ward & Higgins
 To whom it may Concern: Notice is hereby given
 That the undersigned Citizens of the United States of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirtieth of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did on the 24th day of August-AD 1896, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate a lode Claim known as the Genewine Lode or Mining Claim said Claim having been discovered the 24th day of August 1896 and do claim fifty hundred acres feet on the lode, lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries situated in Lookout-Mountain Mining District, County of Skamania State of Washington, said location being described and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent monuments and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:-

Commencing at this stake and notice and running 200 feet in a Southby direction to the center end stake of the Genewine Mine
 Commencing at this stake and Notice it runs 1500 feet in a Northby direction and 100 feet extra to make linear feet to center end stake
 Commencing at center end stake and running in a Westby direction 300 feet and one hundred feet extra to make linear feet along the South of July 20 2nd mine, thence 1500 feet in a Southby direction and 100 feet extra to make linear feet to South West-Corner Stake, thence in a Eastby direction 300 feet and 100 feet extra to make linear feet to center end stake, thence in a Eastby direction 300 feet and 100 feet extra to make linear feet to South East corner Stake, thence in a Northby direction 1500 feet and 100 feet extra to make linear feet to North East corner Stake, thence in a Westby direction along the South of July 20 2nd mine 300 feet & 100 feet extra to make linear feet to the center end stake.
 And we intend to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local customs and rules of miners and the Mining Laws of the United States and of the State of Washington.
