

Notice of Location of "St. Anthony" Mine by Margaret M. Leonard &c.
 To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby
 given, that the undersigned citizens of the United States
 of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having com-
 plied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirteenth
 of the Revised Statute of the United States and of all other min-
 ing laws thereof, and of the State of Washington and the
 local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners, did,
 on the 24th day of August A.D. 1896, locate, and by this notice
 do hereby locate a Lode Claim, known as the St. Anthony Lode
 or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered
 the 24th day of August 1896, and do claim (fifteen hundred
 linear feet on the head, lode or vein bearing mineral in place,
 by six hundred feet in width, the same being three hun-
 dred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with all
 tips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the top
 or apex of which lie within said boundaries) situated in
 Lookout Mountain Mining district County of Chumawuck, State
 of Washington said location being described and distinctly
 marked by reference to natural objects or permanent mon-
 uments, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at this stake and notice and running in
 a South by West direction 200 feet & 100 feet extra to make lineal feet
 to South East corner stake Thence in a North by West direction 1000
 feet & 100 feet extra to make lineal feet to South East corner
 stake of the Genevieve Mine Thence in a West by North direction
 along the Genevieve Mine 200 feet & 100 feet extra to make
 lineal feet to Center end stake Thence along the Genevieve
 Mine 200 feet & 100 feet extra to make lineal feet to South West
 corner stake of the Genevieve Mine Thence in a South by
 West direction 1500 feet & 100 feet extra to make lineal feet to
 South West corner stake, thence in a East by North direction
 200 feet & 100 feet extra to make lineal feet to Center end
 stake of the St. Anthony mine said place of beginning.
