

Notice of Location of "Copper King" mine by J. A. Schwabauer.
 To whom it may concern: Notice is hereby given
 That J. A. Schwabauer a Citizen of the United States
 of America, over the age of twenty-one years, having com-
 plied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two
 of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all other
 Mining laws thereof, and of the Stat. of Washington and
 the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of miners,
 did, on the 15th day of Sept. AD 1896. (local, and by this notice
 do hereby locate a Lode Claim known as the Copper King
 Lode or Mining Claim, said claim having been discovered
 the 15th day of Sept 1896, and do claim (fifteen hundred
 linear feet on this lode, lode or vein bearing mineral in
 place, by six hundred feet in width, the same being three
 hundred feet on each side of the center thereof, together with
 all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins or lodes, the
 top or apex of which lie within said boundaries) (twenty acres
 of placer mining ground), situated in Head Canyon Creek
 County of Seamanes State of Wash., said location being described
 and distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or per-
