

Notice of location Silver King Mine by H.W. Giddings
 To whom it may concern, Notice is hereby given,
 That H.W. Giddings, a citizen of the United States of
 America, over the age of twenty-one years, having com-
 plied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-
 two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and of all
 other mining laws thereof, and of the State of Washing-
 ton and the local customs, laws, rules and regulations of
 miners, did on the 21st day of Sept A.D. 1896, locate, and
 by this notice do hereby locate a lode claim, known as the
 Silver King Lode or Mining Claim said claim having
 been discovered the 19th day of Sept 1896 and do claim
 (fifteen hundred linear feet on this lode, lode or vein bearing
 mineral in place, by six hundred feet in width, the same
 being three hundred feet on each side of the center thereof
 together with all dips, spurs and angles, and all other veins
 or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within said boundaries
 (twenty acres of placer mining ground), Situated in Grand
 Canyon Creek County of Idemania State of Ariz., said
 location being described and distinctly marked by
 reference to natural objects or permanent monuments,
 and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing about 60 ft North of where the Notice is
 posted in big tree where discovery was made being
 North End Center Thence running 300 ft in westerly direc-
 tion to post marked N.W. cor S.K. mine Thence 1500 ft
 in Westerly direction to post marked S.W. cor S.K.
 mine Thence 300 ft in Easterly direction to tree marked
 South End Center S.K. mine Thence 300 ft Easterly to post mar-
 ked S.E. cor S.K. mine Thence 1500 ft in Northerly direction
 to post marked N.E. cor S.K. mine Thence 300 ft Westerly
 to place of beginning where copy of this Notice is posted
