

Notice of Location of "James Mine" by Hervey Gernall
 To whom it may concern, Notice is hereby given
 That Hervey Gernall a Citizen of the United States of America
 over the age of twenty-one years, having complied with the
 requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised
 Statutes of the United States and of all other mining laws
 thereof, and of the State of Washington and the local customs,
 laws, rules and regulations of Miners, did on the Second day of
 September AD 1896, locate, and by this notice do hereby locate
 a Lode Claim, known as the "James" Lode or Mining Claim
 said claim having been discovered the Second day of September
 1896, and do claim (fifteen hundred linear feet on the lead,
 lode or vein bearing mineral in place, by six hundred feet
 in width, the same being three hundred feet on each side
 of the center thereof, together with all dips, spurs and angles
 and all other veins or lodes, the top or apex of which lie within
 said boundaries) situated in Lookout-Mining D. County of
 Skamania State of Washington said location being described and
 distinctly marked by reference to natural objects or permanent
 monuments, and more particularly described as follows to-wit:

From Center Stake of Notice running in a Easterly direction
 (300) three hundred linear feet to the South East corner Stake, from
 thence Northerly (1500) fifteen hundred linear feet to North
 East corner Stake, from thence running in a Westerly direction
 to the End Center Stake (300) three hundred linear feet
 from thence running a Westerly direction (300) three hundred
 linear feet to the North West corner Stake from thence (1000)
 fifteen hundred linear feet in a Southerly direction to the South
 West corner Stake, from thence (300) three hundred linear feet in
 a Easterly direction to the center Stake of Notice. The same being
 located (70) seventy feet linear in a North Westerly direction
 from prospecting shaft, the same adjoining the Claim known as the
 Omega Claim, situated in the Lookout-Mining District. And I intend
 to hold and work said claim in accordance with the local cus-
 toms and rules of Miners and the mining laws of the United
 States and of the State of Washington.
