## THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, A CERTIFICATE OF THE REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE AR VANCOUVER, WASH-INGTON, HAS BEEN DEPOSITED IN THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE, WHEREBY IT APPEARS THAT FULL PAYMENT HAS BEEN MADE BY THE CLAIMANT KARL DAVID STENMAN ACCORDING TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE ACT OF CONGRESS OF APRIL 24, 1820, ENTITLED "AN ACT MAKING FURTHER PROVISIONS FOR THE SALE OF THE PUBLIC LANDS," AND THE ACTS SUPPLEMENTAL THERETO, FOR THE

SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER, THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER, AND THE NORTH HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION TWENTY-FIVE IN TOWNSHIP TWO NORTH OF RANGE FIVE EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, WASHINGTON, CONTAINING ONE HUNDRED SIXTY ACRES,

ACCORDING TO THE OFFICIAL PLAT OF THE SURVEY OF THE SAID LAND, RETURNED TO THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE BY THE SURVEYOR-GENERAL:

NOW KNOW YE, THAT THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES, AND IN CONFORMITY WITH THE SEVERAL ACTS OF CONGRESS IN SUCH CASE MADE AND PROVIDED, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, AND BY THESE PRESENTS DOES GIVE AND GRANT, UNTO THE SAID CLAIMANT AND TO THE HEIRS OF THE SAID CLAIMANT THE TRACT ABOVE DESCRIBED; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, TOGETHER WITH ALL THE RIGHTS, PRIVILEGES, IMMUNITIES, AND APPURTENANCES, OF WHATSOEVER NATURE, THEREUNTO BELONGING, UNTO THE SAID CLAIMANT AND TO THE HEIRS AND ASSIGNS OF THE SAID CLAIMANT FOREVER; SUBJECT TO ANY VESTED AND ACCRUED WATER RIGHTS FOR MINING, AGRICULTURAL, MANUFACTURING, OR OTHER PURPOSES, AND RIGHTS TO DITCHES AND RESERVOIRS USED IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH WATER RIGHTS, AS MAY BE RECOGNIZED AND ACKNOWLEDGED BY THE LOCAL OUSTOMS, LAWS, AND DECISIONS OF COURTS; AND THERE IS RESERVED FROM THE LANDS HEREBY GRANTED, A RIGHT OF WAY FOR DITCHES OR CANALS CONSTRUCTED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE UNITED STATES.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I WOODROW! WILSON PRESIDENT OF THE United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
