Notice to Heretofore Officers that Harry Nelson, of Underwood, Skamania county, state of Washington, claims a lien upon a lot of fir saw logs, being about 500,000 feet in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania county, state of Washington, part of the said logs being marked thus "W" on end, and some of said logs being unmarked, and are now lying in the White Salmon river in township number 3 north of range 10 east of Tillamette Meridian, in said Skamania county, state of Washington, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in barking, falling and bucking said logs, that the name of the owner or reputed owner is the White Salmon Room & Improvement Co., George H. Nicolai, agent, that D. D. McIntyre, who is a contractor and agent for George H. Nicolai, employed said Harry Nelson to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

The said D. D. McIntyre agreed to pay the said Harry Nelson, for such labor and assistance \$2.25 per day; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said Harry Nelson, who performed labor upon and assisted in manufacturing and securing said saw logs for the period of 53 days; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said saw logs between the 16th day of September, 1901, and the 20 day of November, 1901; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 20 day of November, 1901, and 30 days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demand for said service is \$119.25; that no part thereof has been paid except \$122.00 and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$87.25, in which amount he claims a lien upon said saw logs. ~~that~~ The said Harry Nelson also claims a lien on said saw logs now owned by said White Salmon Room & Improvement Co. George H. Nicolai, agent, or the said D. D. McIntyre to secure payment for logs and saw logs herein described.

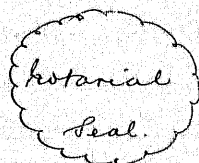
