Notice is hereby given that E. M. St. Martin of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a certain lot of saw-logs, being about two hundred and fifty thousand feet in quantity which were cut and manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington and are now lying in Wood River Skamania County Wash. also on a certain boom lying at the mouth of Wood River in said County and State for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in manufacturing said boom, that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Benham and Barry, W. Anderson, Stephen Vinson; that Benham & Barry employed E. M. St. Martin to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

That said Benham & Barry agreed to pay the said E. M. St. Martin for such labor and assistance $3\frac{1}{2}$ cts per foot for 940 feet and agreed further to pay board for the landfair and C. M. Benham & works at \$3.50 per week and for 4 days work at \$2.00 per day that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of E. M. St. Martin who performed labor upon and assisted in manufacturing said boom; that said labor and assistance was so performed and rendered upon said boom and said board was contracted for and furnished between the 10th day of December 1897 and the 7th day of February 1898; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 7th day of February 1898 and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimants demand for said service is \$61⁹⁰, that no part thereof has been paid except \$3⁰⁰, and there is now due and

remaining unpaid thereon, after deducting
all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$58.00
in which amount he claims a lien upon said
