THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting;

WHEREAS, ISAAC LIEBES, BEING THE OWNER OF A TRACT OF LAND SITUATED AND INCLUDED WITHIN THE LIMITS OF A PUBLEC FOREST RESERVATION, KNOWN AND OFFICIALLY DESIGNATED AS THE PINE MOUNTAIN AND ZACA LAKE FOREST RESERVE, CALIFORNIA, HAS, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE ACT APPROVED JUNE 4, 1897, ENTITLED, "AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR SUNDRY CIVIL EXPENSES OF THE GOVERNMENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE THIRTIETH, EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-EIGHT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES," RECONVEYED AND RELINQUISHED THE SAID TRACT TO THE UNITED STATES AND HAS, UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE SAID ACT, SELECTED IN LIEU THEREOF THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED TRACT OF OVACANT PUBLIC LAND NOW OPEN TO SETTLEMENT, TOWNIT:

THE LOTS THREE AND SIX OF SECTION EIGHT IN TOWNSHIP EIGHT NORTH OF RANGE SIX EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, WASHINGTON, CONTAINING EIGHTY-ONE ACRES AND SIXTY-SEVEN HUNDREDTHS OF AN ACRE, ACCORDING TO THE OFFICIAL PLAT OF THE SURVEY OF THE SAID LAND, RETURNED TO THE GENERAL EAND OFFICE BY THE SURVEYOR GENERAL:

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Isaac Liebes, and to his heirs, the land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Isaac Liebes, and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, CALVIN COOLIDGE, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, HAVE CAUSED THESE LETTERS TO BE MADE PATENT, AND THE SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE TO BE HEREUNTO AFFIXED. GIVEN UNDER MY HAND, AT THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, THE TWENTY-FOURTH DAY OF MAY IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FOUR AND OF THE INDEPENDENCE OF THE UNITED STATES THE ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY-EIGHTH
