BIDDLE ACCORDING TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE ACT OF CONGRESS OF APRIL 24, 1820, ENTITLED "AN ACT MAKING FURTHER PROVISIONS FOR THE SALE OF THE PUBLIC LANDS," AND THE ACTS SUPPLEMENTAL THERETO, FOR THE

Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section Thirteen and the East half of the Northeast quarter and the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section Twenty-four in Township Two North of Range Six East of the Willamette Merddian, Washington, containing One Hundred Sixty acres,

ACCORDING TO THE OFFICIAL PLAT OF THE SURVEY OF THE SAID LAND, RETURNED TO THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE BY THE SURVEYOR-GENERAL:

NOW KNOW YE, THAT THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES, AND IN CONFORMITY WITH THE SEVERAL ACTS OF CONGRESS IN SUCH CASE MADE AND PROVIDED, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, AND BY THESE PRESENTS DOES GIVE AND GRANT UNTO THE SAID GLAIMANT AND TO THE HEIRS OF THE SAID CLAIMANT THE TRACT ABOVE DESCRIBED; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, TOGETHER WITH ALL THE RIGHTS, PRIVILEGES, IMMUNITIES, AND APPURTENANCES, OF WHATSOEVER NATURE, THEREUNTO BELONGING, UNTO THE SAID CLAIMANT AND TO THE HEIRS AND ASSIGNS OF THE SAID CLAIMANT FOREVER; SUBJECT TO ANY VESTED AND ACCRUED WATER RIGHTS FOR MINING AGRICULTURAL, MANUFACTURING, OR OTHER PURPOSES, AND RIGHTS TO DITCHES AND RESERVOIRS USED IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH WATER RIGHTS, AS MAY BE RECOGNIZED AND ACKNOWLEDGED BY THE LOCAL CUSTOMS, LAWS, AND DECISIONS OF COURTS; AND THERE HEREBY IS RESERVED FROM THE LANDS GRANTED, A RIGHT OF WAY THEREON FOR DITCHES OR CANALS CONSTRUCTED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE UNITED STATES.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, CALVIN COOLIDGE, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, HAVE CAUSED THESE LETTERS TO BE MADE PATENT, AND THE SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE TO BE HEREUNTO AFFIXED.
