 or in any wise appertaining to have and
 to hold the same with the appurtenances
 unto the said Chas Brown his heirs
 and assigns forever. This conveyance
 is intended as a mortgage to secure the
 payment of the sum of Two hundred and
 twenty five Dollars and the interest thereon
