Reese & Brindle his wife of Multnomah County Oregon have bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do bargain sell and convey unto the said Charles & F. J. Reese all of the following described premises to wit: Lot No one (1) of section No one (1) the North west quarter of the North East quarter; the North half of the North west quarter and lots Nos one (1) Two (2) Three (3) and Four (4) of section No Eleven (11) and lots Nos one (1) Two (2) Three (3) and Four (4) of section No Twelve (12) all in Township No One (1) North of Range No Five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian containing three hundred and eighty eight (388) acres and situate in the County of Shumaker Washington Territory Together with the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said Charles & F. J. Reese his heirs and assigns forever This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of thirty two hundred and fifty dollars and the interest thereon in accordance with the tenor of a certain promissory note of which the following is a copy to wit: \$3250 ¹⁰⁰ Vancouver W. T. March 4th 1884 For value received we jointly and severally promise to pay to the order of Charles & F. J. Reese thirty two hundred and fifty (3250) Dollars in United States Gold coin with interest thereon at the rate of eight percent per annum in like Gold coin The interest on this entire note and one hundred Dollars of the principal sum shall be due and payable on the fourth day of March 1885 The interest on the balance remaining due and five hundred Dollars of the principal sum shall be due and payable on the fourth day of March 1886 All of the interest and five hundred Dollars of the principal sum shall be due
