

Jack Connors vs. St. Helens Gold & Copper Company.

Labor Lien upon Land.

Notice is hereby given, that on or about the 21st day of August 1903, Jack Connors, the above named claimant, at the request of the above named St. Helens Gold and Copper Company and of its president and trustee, R. L. Mc Kenzie, commenced to perform labor upon four certain mining locations and claims, described as follows: Lumber No. 1, Lumber No. 2, Hidden Treasure No. 1 and Hidden Treasure No. 2, situated near the center of Section 4 Township 9 North of Range 6 East of Willamette Meridian in Multnomah County, Washington, and which said claims are more particularly described in the original location notices thereof now of record in Mining Records of said County and State, and all of which said real property, the owner and reputed owner is the said St. Helens Gold and Copper Company, a corporation of Oregon, that the performance of said labor so commenced by claimant, ceased on the 28th day of October, 1903, and the amount of labor so performed, being of the value of \$100. upon each and every of the four above described mining locations and the claimant intends to and does hereby designate the amount of his claims due him to be \$100. on each and every of the above mentioned mining claims. That the said labor performed was of the total value of Four hundred Dollars (\$400.) and no part nor the whole of which has been paid except \$40. and for which said labor the claimant being the undersigned, claims a lien upon the property therein described for the sum of Three hundred sixty Dollars (\$360.)
