NOW KNOW YE, THAT THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES, AND IN CONFORMITY WITH THE SEVERAL ACTS OF CONGRESS IN SUCH CASE MADE AND PROVIDED, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, AND BY THESE PRESENTS DO GIVE AND GRANT, UNTO THE SAID LEWIS C. BARKER AND TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, TOGETHER WITH ALL THE RIGHTS, PRIVILEGES, IMMUNITIES, AND APPURTENANCES, OF THEREUNTO BELONGING, UNTO THE SAID LEWIS C. BARKER AND APPURTENANCES, OF WHATSOEVER NATURE, AND TO HIS HEIRS AND ASSIGNS FOREVER; SUBJECT TO ANY VESTED AND ACCRUED WATER RIGHTS FOR MINING, AGRICULTURE, MANUFACTURING, OR OTHER PURPOSES, AND RIGHTS TO DITCHES AND RESERVOIRS USED IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH WATER RIGHTS, AS MAY BE RECOGNIZED AND ACKNOWLEDGED BY THE LOCAL CUSTOMS, LAWS, AND DECISIONS OF COURTS, AND ALSO SUBJECT TO THE RIGHT OF THE PROPRIETOR OF A VEIN OR LODE TO EXTRACT AND REMOVE HIS ORE THEREFROM, SHOULD THE SAME BE FOUND TO PENETRATE OR INTERSECT THE PREMISES HEREBY GRANTED, AS PROVIDED BY LAW; AND THERE IS RESERVED FROM THE LANDS HEREBY GRANTED, A RIGHT OF WAY THEREON FOR DITCHES OR CANALS CONSTRUCTED BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE UNITED STATES,

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF I, Theodore Roosevelt, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
