This indenture made the 13th day of September, in the year of our Lord, One Thousand, Eight Hundred, and Seventy One (1871) between Fred Willson, of Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon, party of the first part, and Horace A. Leavens, of Skamania County, Washington Territory, party of the second part, "Witnesseth" Thus the said party of the first part, for, and in consideration of the sum Three Hundred Dollars Gold Coin of the United States of America, to him in hand paid, by the said party of the second part - the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has granted, bargained, sold, aliened, remised, released, conveyed and confirmed, and by those presents, does grant, bargain, sell, alien release remise, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and his heirs, and assigns forever. All those certain tracts, lots, and parcels of land, lying and being situate in Skamania County, Washington Territory, and more particularly described in the Maps, and Plats of the United States Land Office, as the North East-Quarter, of the North West-Quarter, of Section No Six (6) in Township No One (1) North of Range Six (6) East, containing Forty Acres of Land, it being the same tract of land paid for by James E. Lotten to the Receiver of the United States Land Office at Vancouver B.C., and also that certain other tract, and parcel of Land situate in said County, of Skamania, and known and described as the West-Half, of the North East-Quarter and Lots Nos One (1) and Two (2) of Section No Six (6) in Township No One (1) North of Range No Six (6) East, containing One Hundred and Fifty One acres (151) it being the same tract of land formerly preempted by Robert McBlure, both tracts of land containing One Hundred, and Ninety One Acres (191).
