 On S 82 W there has been at least One Hundred and twelve
 Dollars worth of work or improvements made in actual
 work. On NE $\frac{1}{4}$ E there has been at least One Hundred Dollars
 worth of work or improvements made in trail from mining
 creek to this place. The above claims are situated in
 Cispus (St. Helens) Mining District County of Skamania
 State of Wash. The work or improvements were made
 between the 1st day of Jan 1896, and the 31st day of Dec
