

P. O. Hurlburt vs. Isaac Foster

Notice is hereby given that P. O. Hurlburt of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a quantity of piling, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington, and said piling are now lying in a slough in or near Stevenson in said county and state, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in sawing and falling said piling; that the owner or reputed owner is Isaac Foster; That he employed said P. O. Hurlburt to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit:

The said Isaac Foster agreed to pay said P. O. Hurlburt two dollars per day for such labor and assistance; that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully completed with by on the part of said claimant, who performed labor upon and assisted in sawing and falling said piling for the period of about one month; that said labor and assistance were so performed and rendered upon said piling between about the dates of March 19, to and April 20, 1905 and the rendition of said services ceased on April 19, 1905, and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of said claimants demand for said service is \$11.00 after deducting all just credits and offsets, in which amount he claims a lien upon said piling, together with \$11.50 costs. The said claimant also demands a lien upon all said piling now owned by said Isaac Foster of said county, to secure the payment for the work and labor performed in falling and sawing said piling herein described.

Oscar Bevans, Claimant vs. Foster & Barr.

Notice is hereby given that Oscar Bevans of Skamania County State of Washington claims a lien upon a lot of cottonwood logs lying about 100000 ft, more or less in quantity, which were cut in Skamania County, State of Washington, are marked with three an marks, and are now lying in the Columbia River at the Redner Place near Battle Rock in said county, for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in getting said logs into the river; that the owner or reputed owner is Foster & Barr, that they employed said Oscar Bevans to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to wit: The said Foster and Barr agreed to pay the said Oscar Bevans for such labor and assistance two and $\frac{3}{4}$ dollars per day; That said contract has been faithfully performed and fully

completed with on the part of said claimant who performed labor upon and assisted in putting said logs into the river for the period from April 18th to June 7, 1905; that said labor and assistance were so performed upon said logs between the day of 13th day of April 1905 and the 7th day of June 1905; and the rendition of said service was closed on the 7th day of June 1905 and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of claimant's demands which is now due and remains unpaid after deducting all just credits and offsets is \$194.35, in which amount he claims a lien upon said logs. The said claimant also claims a lien on all said logs now owned by said Foster and Barr to secure payment for the work and labor performed in obtaining or securing the said logs or other timbers therein herein described, together with costs of this lien.
