

This Indenture made the 8th day of
 April 1884 by and between H. B.
 Borthwick and Walter F. Faine
 Composing the firm of Borthwick and
 Faine residing Cascade Mills
 County of Skamania Washington Territory party
 of the first Part and A. E. Borthwick
 of Portland County of Multnomah Oregon
 Party of of the second part Witnesseth
 That for and in Consideration of the
 Sum of Fifteen Hundred dollars lawful
 Money of the United States to us in hand
 Paid by the said party of the second
 part. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have granted bargained. sold assigned and
 transferred and set over and by these presents
 do grant bargain and sell assign transfer
 and set over unto the said party of the
 second part all those certain goods and
 Chattles now being in. a certain Mill
 Called the Sprague Mill situated on the
 North side of the Columbia River
 in Skamania County Washington Territory
 About one mile north of said Columbia
 River and about eight miles above the
 Cascade Locks. and described as follows
 to wit two (2) Engines two (2) boilers.
 California one and a half (1 1/2) Flamer
 Saws shafting Belting Carriages Together
 with all and singular all other Machinery
 And fixtures of whatever nature and
 description to said Mill above mentioned
 And described appertaining and belonging.
 to have and to hold all and singular
 the said goods and Chattles above bargained
 and sold or intended so to be. unto the
 said party of the second part his Executors
 Administrators and assigns forever Provided
 nevertheless. and these presents are upon
 their express Condition that Whereas
