This Indenture, Made the fourth day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight, Between John F. Boyer and Sarah E. Boyer his wife of the County of Walla Walla and Territory of Washington parties of the first part, and the Oregon Steam Navigation Company a Corporation existing under the laws of the State of Oregon, party of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, for and inconsideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred Dollars, Gold Coin of the United States, to them in hand paid, by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have sold, conveyed, remised, released and confirmed, and by these presents, do sell, convey, remise, release and confirm unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, all the right, title interest, claim and demand which the said parties parties of the first part have in and to the following real estate, land and premises lying and being in the County of Skamania Territory of Washington, and more particularly described as follows, to wit: The south west quarter of the North East quarter of Section Fifteen (15) and lots numbered Two (2) and Three (3) in Section Twenty (20) all in Township Two (2) North of Range Seven (7) East Containing Fifty two and 50/100 acres. Also that parcel of land situate at the Cascades of the Columbia River in said County (at the portage ) and being the wives portion of the Donation Claim of F. A. Chenoweth and Elizabeth A Chenoweth his wife, and bounded as follows, to wit: On the South side by the Columbia river, on the West side by the donation Claim of B.B. Bishop, on, theNorth side by the Cascade Mountains and on the East side by that portion of said donation Claim heretofore awarded to F.A.Chenoweth: said described tract containing Three Hundred and Twenty acres (320) excepting however a right of way heretofore granted for a railroad, by said Chenoweth and wife.
