

Notice of Location of the Lost Hope Lode by D. Gutzwil
 The Lost Hope Lode Claim No. 1. Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six, of title thirty two of the revised Statutes of the United States and local customs laws and regulations has located fifteen hundred linear feet on the Lost Hope Lode situated in St. Helens Mining District State of Washington and described as follows:

Beginning at a post in center of Lode and in center of Boulder Gulch about 50 feet above first high cliff in said Gulch about 1/2 mile in a North Westerly direction from the Black Falls on Green River also known as the North Fork of the Toutle River. Thence three hundred linear feet in a Southerly direction to a Stake Thence fifteen hundred linear feet in a Easterly direction to a Stake. Thence six hundred linear feet in a North by direction to a Stake passing at 300 feet a stake indicating center of lode Thence fifteen hundred linear feet in a Westerly direction to a Stake Thence three hundred linear feet in a Southerly direction to place of beginning including all dips spurs crooks and angles
