Notice is hereby given that J. A. St. Martin of Skamania County, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a certain lot of saw logs lying about two hundred and fifty thousand feet in quantity, which were cut or manufactured in Skamania County, State of Washington and are marked thus "L" on both sides and are now lying in Wind River, also on a certain boom at the mouth of Wind River, Skamania County Wash. for labor performed upon and assistance rendered in manufacturing said boom; that the name of the owner or reputed owner is Benham & Barff, W. Anderson, Stephen Vinson; that Benham & Barff employed said J. A. St. Martin to perform such labor and render such assistance upon the following terms and conditions, to-wit:

That said Benham and Barff agreed to pay the said J. A. St. Martin for such labor and assistance \$2.00 per day that said contract has been faithfully performed and fully complied with on the part of said J. A. St. Martin who performed labor upon and assisted in manufacturing said Boom for the period of six days; that said labor and assistance were performed and rendered upon said Boom between the 15th day of December 1897 and the 10th day of January A. D. 1898, and the rendition of said services was closed on the 10th day of January A. D. 1898 and thirty days have not elapsed since that time; that the amount of Claimant's demand for said service is \$12.00 and there is now due and remaining unpaid thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets the sum of \$12.00 in which amount he claims a lien.
