

Location of the 'Sams' Mine

Notice of Location

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned having complied with the requirements of Chapter Six of Title Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes of the United States and the local customs laws and regulations, has located fifteen hundred linear feet on the Samsen Lode in St Helens Mining District supposed to be in Lewis County State of Washington and described as follows: -

Beginning at a post at the face of the Samsen Tunnel claim as the point of discovery and bordering on the south line of said Tunnel claim and running thence (without variation) S 35° W 300 feet S 55° E 1500 feet N 35° E 600 feet N 55° W 500 feet and thence S 35° W 300 feet to point of beginning

The point of discovery of this claim is on the Samsen gulch (swept by snow slide) about one mile north to north west from a beaver swamp on the north side of the north fork of Tuttle or Green River near the headwaters on the south slope of Goat Mountain and about six miles west of where the Cispus trail crosses the same Mountain in St Helens Mining District supposed to be in Lewis County State of Washington
