George W. Gray, Claimant,

Logger's Lien

Notice is hereby given that George W. Gray of Stevenson, County of Skamania, State of Washington, claims a lien upon a number of rail-road ties, being about Eleven hundred in number, which were cut in Skamania County State of Washington, a portion thereof being marked with three notches and are now lying on the right of way of the Portland and Seattle Rail road near Home Valley State of Washington or near said right of way near said place known as Home Valley in the said County and State, for labor performed in cutting, dressing and preparing said ties; that the name of the owner, or reputed owner of said ties is Johnson Porter; That the said A. M. Lindsay is the agent, or foreman or sub-contractor of the said Johnson Porter and that the said A. M. Lindsay employed the said George W. Gray to perform such labor upon the following terms to wit:- The said A. M. Lindsay agreed to pay the said George W. Gray for six inch face ties \$12 per tie and for ties of more than six inch face \$15 cut, dressed, and prepared by him. That the said George W. Gray so cut, dressed and prepared 1520 ties in pursuance of the said agreement of employment entered into with the said A. M. Lindsay to wit; 189 six inch face ties and 1381 ties of more than six inch face; that the said work has been faithfully performed by the said George W. Gray and that said labor was performed upon said ties between the twenty fifth day of October 1906 and the 8th day of March 1907 and said work was completed on the 8th day of March 1907, and thirty days have not elapsed since the completion thereof. That the amount of claimant's demand for said services is \$217.55; that no part thereof has been paid except the sum of \$66.35 and the sum of \$40.00 and there is now due and payable thereon after deducting all just credits and offsets, the sum of \$111.20 in which amount the said

George W. Gray claims a lien upon said ties. The said George W. Gray also claims a lien upon all ties now owned by the said A. M. Lindsay and the said Johnson Porter or either of them to secure the payment for the work and labor performed in cutting, dressing and preparing the ties herein described.
